Being so near the river, the foundations caused considerable difficulty, and necessitated its being built on broad beds of concrete, these continuing in some places to the level of the river bed. The design, by Messrs. Gordon, Lowther, and Gunton, of Finsbury House, E. C. , whose plans were selected from among those of nine competitors, is in the Perpendicular style of Gothic, with several late Decorated features. The material is red brick, with...
